# **EARTHWORKS FOR COLD CLIMATE WATER RESILIENCY**



**Drought and flood are two sides of the same coin:** A broken water cycle is the root cause of both. Join Takota Coen from Coen Farm and Rob Avis from Verge Permaculture for a 2-day workshop at the Coen Farm and the nearby Ferintosh Hall to learn how to design and implement low-tech, low-cost, nature-based earthworks that can build more effective and efficient water cycles on your land. The workshop will include a mixture of in-class presentation and activity time at the Hall, and field trips out to the Coen Farm where a 30-ton excavator and D3 Bulldozer will be actively constructing a variety of earthworks.
