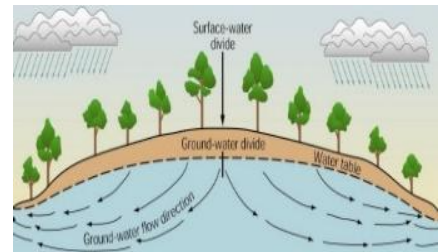
Tree planting will take place at the joint headwaters of
